### BYLAW NO. 76, 2011

#### A Bylaw to Rescind Road Closure Bylaw No. 48, 2009

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**WHEREAS** Canadian Forest Products Ltd. initiated an indefinite closure of their Vavenby Division industrial plant located on McCorvie Road in Vavenby, British Columbia;

**AND WHEREAS** in order to secure their industrial plant, Canadian Forest Products Ltd. had requested that the District close McCorvie Road to vehicular traffic until the plant reopens;

**AND WHEREAS** Canadian Forest Products Ltd. is requesting the road closure bylaw be rescinded due to the plant reopening on September 6, 2011,

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of the District of Clearwater, in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

**1. CITATION**

This bylaw shall be cited as the "District of Clearwater Rescinding Bylaw No. 76, 2011 a Bylaw to rescind Road Closure Bylaw No. 48, 2009".

**2. MISCELLANEOUS**


This bylaw shall come into force and effect on and after the 16<sup>th</sup> of August, 2011.



READ A SECOND TIME THIS 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2011.


READ A THIRD TIME THIS 11<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2011.
