



**Temporary Road Closure – Dike Road Adjacent to District of Clearwater  
Sewage Treatment Lagoons**

Please be advised that in consultation with Canfor staff the District of Clearwater has temporarily closed to vehicular traffic the portion of the dike road that is adjacent to the District's sewage treatment lagoons at the end of Webber Road. Effective immediately use is restricted to pedestrian and bicycle traffic along this portion of the dike road. The closure will be lifted on November 30, 2009.

The effected roadway is located on private property and the landowner has graciously agreed to allow the District this temporary closure to vehicular traffic.

This temporary road closure has been enacted to facilitate the completion of sewage treatment facility upgrades as mandated by Interior Health Authority. The District has received \$400,000 in grant funding from the Provincial Government to complete this project.
