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The Council of the District of Clearwater gives notice that it will hold a Public Hearing on **Wednesday, August 5, 2020 at 6:30 pm** in Council Chambers at 209 Dutch Lake Road, Clearwater, BC, to consider further input on a proposed Liquor Primary Licence.

What is the purpose of this Notice of Intent for Liquor Licence Application No. LL-20-01?

The purpose of this notice is to advise the public regarding a proposed liquor primary licence at 290 Road 2A FSR (see map below). Key information is as follows:

Name of proposed establishment: ATCO Clearwater Lounge (Applicant: ATCO Frontec Ltd.).

Location of proposed establishment: 290 Road 2A FSR (Legal Description: NW1/4, District Lot 1680, KDYD, Except Plan KAP54894; PID: 009-303-570).

Purpose of hearing: This is the second hearing for this application. The first hearing was held on July 14, 2020. The purpose of this hearing is for Council to gather further input from the public regarding the proposal to have a liquor primary licence at the pipeline project work camp (currently being set up) to provide liquor service after-work hours to employees and registered guests only (no general public access). Submissions may be either vocal (at the Hearing date) or written (submitted prior to the Hearing).

Details of proposal: Indoor seating capacity for 130 persons; proposed hours of liquor service: 5:30 pm to 10:30 pm (Monday to Sunday; 7 days/week).

All persons who believe that they may be affected by the proposed application shall be afforded a reasonable opportunity to be heard at the Public Hearing. Additionally, they may make written submissions on the matter (via the adjacent options) which must be received at our office **prior to 4:30 p.m. on the 4th day of August, 2020**. The entire content of all submissions will be made public and form a part of the public record for this matter.

A copy of the application information can be inspected from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Mon. to Fri. (except statutory holidays) at our office from July 23rd until 4:30 p.m. the day of the August 5th Hearing; or please contact us via any of the adjacent options.
