What is a Trails Task Force you ask? The District has adopted a Trails Master Plan and has been developing a trail system within the municipal boundaries. The purpose of the Task Force is to support the implementation of the Trails Master Plan which includes developing safe, connected and functional recreational trails. The Task Force works with District staff to navigate the legal responsibilities of establishing these trails and providing recommendations to Council on trail development. The Task Force is seeking one (1) new member from the public who is interested in furthering the goals of the committee in creating safe, connected and functional multi-use trails for the purposes of both recreation and commuting routes.
