RE: Candidate Information for the 2022 Local General Election

Thank you for your interest in the 2022 General Local Election scheduled to be held on October 15, 2022. A person is qualified to be nominated to run for Mayor or Council if they meet the following requirements:

- are at least 18 years old on voting day;
- are a Canadian citizen;
- have lived in British Columbia for at least 6 months;
- have not been disqualified by law

In addition to this letter please ensure you have also received:

- **2022 Candidate Nomination Package** – includes Forms C1 (cover sheet), C2 (Nomination Documents), C3 (Other Information Provided by Candidate), C4 (Appointment of Financial Agent), C5 (Appointment of Official Agent) and C6 (Appointment of Candidate Scrutineer) as well as the Statement of Disclosure and Candidate Information Release Authorization. The Package must be filed with the Chief Election Officer between 9:00 AM on Tuesday August 30, 2022 and 4:00 PM on Friday September 9, 2022
- **2022 District of Clearwater Nomination Information Guide** – includes lots of additional information about the upcoming election, the role of Council and the District of Clearwater, qualifications for office, and legislative excerpts. Provided for the convenience of candidates seeking election in the District of Clearwater for the offices of Mayor or Council.
- **2022 (Provincial) Candidate's Guide to Local Elections in B.C** – Guide prepared by the province to learn more about being a candidate for local office.

These documents are available for download on the District of Clearwater website or you can pick up a printed copy at the Municipal Office located at 209 Dutch Lake Road. Further information regarding the 2022 General Local Election will be advertised in the local newspapers beginning in early August and on the District of Clearwater website at <https://www.districtofclearwater.com/residents/2022-municipal-election/>.
